- Strong research base within food technology and nutritional science







Mia. kr., kædede 2005-priser, sæsonkorrigeret







Middelklassens udvikling 2009-2020







Increasing demand for healthy products


Salg af sundhedsfremmende fødevarer i Europa og USA (mia. USD)


